

WHAT'S INCLUDED

AORN's Learning Center (ALC) includes the following access:

- Administrators – Two (2) year access including student modules
- Students – Six (6) month access
- Preceptors – Three (3) month access

Nursing Contact Hours

- 41.7 CH for Operating Room RNs
- 35.6 CH for OB RN Circulators
- 42.9 CH for Ambulatory Surgery Center RNs

Online Administrator Implementation Guide


