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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Definitions

Administrator

The individual listed on the order form who manages and facilitates students through the Fundamentals of Perioperative Practice course (may also be the Facility Representative/ Designated Contact).

• AORN Learning Center (ALC)

AORN's proprietary Web-enabled learning management system and service updates. The ALC is comprised of the Web sites and all related hardware, software, code, databases, data, and connectivity provided or used by AORN.

• Facility Representative/Designated Contact

Primary contact in the event AORN needs to contact the listed facility and the Administrator is not available.

• Invoice/Order Form

The order form that includes the Terms and Conditions and is signed by the authorized facility representative.

• Master Facility

The facility signing the Fundamentals of Perioperative Practice agreement—the only site for a single-site agreement, or the lead facility for a multi-site agreement.

• Fundamentals of Perioperative Practice

The course learning modules, tests, and all other materials made available to Students and Administrator(s) through AORN's learning management system.

• Preceptor

Individual designated by the Administrator to take the Preceptor Module – this person has access only to the Preparing the Preceptor module.

• Student

Individual designated on the roster to use a purchased Fundamentals of Perioperative Practice student seat for the licensed facility.

Administrators

AORN will provide complimentary course Administrator registrations according to the Price List. A minimum of one Administrator is required per facility or subfacility. The Administrator must provide a roster of the students they intend to enroll in the course. See attached document.

Each Administrator, Student, and Preceptor will have a username and password as part of the registration process.

One Administrator for each facility/site must complete the Administrator course before Students are granted access to the course.

Students

Students **cannot** participate in Fundamentals of Perioperative Practice without a Course Administrator. Students will have 6 months to complete the course from the time they complete online registration.

Clinical Preceptorships

AORN does not provide a clinical preceptorship or practicum in connection with Fundamentals of Perioperative Practice. It is the responsibility of the Administrator to provide a clinical preceptorship and practicum and to establish the competency of Students.

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Contact Hours

Administrators and Preceptors who are registered nurses are eligible for nursing contact hours upon successful completion their respective courses and Post Tests.

Access Controls

Administrators, Students, and Preceptors are solely responsible for ensuring that their user names, passwords, and access numbers are not shared with other individuals and that appropriate measures are implemented to keep those secret and confidential.

Expiration Term for Administrators, Students, and Preceptors

- Administrators will have access to the Administrator Course and all student modules for the **12-month** (one-year) term of the agreement, starting on the date AORN sends the Administrator the course start instructions by email.
- Administrators who are added during the term will have access for the remainder of that term.
- All unused Administrator, Student, and Preceptor seats will expire 12 months following the date AORN sends the Administrator the
 course start email.
- Students will have 6 months to successfully complete the Fundamentals of Perioperative Practice course from the date they register online.
- Preceptors will have **3 months** to successfully complete the Preceptor Module from the date AORN registers them online and sends them the registration confirmation by e-mail.
- Upon expiration of the agreement, the facility must purchase another agreement to continue access to the Fundamentals of Perioperative Practice. Access to the course will be denied if a facility chooses not to purchase another agreement.

Fees and Payment

All fees are nonrefundable.

Restrictions

Under no circumstances shall Course Administrators, Students, or Preceptors use or permit the use of any downloaded or printed Fundamentals of Perioperative Practice materials to develop other training materials or competing products or services. The ALC and Fundamentals of Perioperative Practice content must <u>not</u> be reverse engineered, disassembled, or removed, and all copyrights and privacy notices contained in Fundamentals of Perioperative Practice shall remain intact.

Course Administrator, Student, or Preceptor information may not be shared or transferred from one person to another.

Course Administrators, Students, and Preceptors will comply with all Terms and Conditions of this agreement.

Student, Preceptor and Administrator registrations/seats are not transferable once the person has registered online for the course.
