The Introduction to Perioperative Nursing course is for undergraduate nurses and provides fundamental knowledge of pre, intra, and post-operative surgical practices. Nursing schools can incorporate the course into their curriculum as an introduction to the challenging and exciting perioperative nursing profession. The 17-module course includes QSEN competencies and focuses on key infection prevention concepts, preventing complications in the surgical patient, and teaches how to look at the patient and identify potential complications.
